Meeting Minutes

Bond Money:

- When the school receives bond funding, Bradley uses the funds in a way that always prioritizes the students. Previous years funds allowed for upgrades to the gym, cafeteria painting, auditorium updates, etc.
- Library is all new! The technology lab is being painted now.
- All new WiFi was installed around the outside of the school this enables the teachers to hold classes outside throughout the year.
- Over the summer, Bradley was supposed to get an outdoor classroom, but this has been delayed. Expect this still to happen in the future!
- o All teachers received new laptops.
- 3-5th graders got new touch screen Chromebooks; kinder-1st had new Chromebooks last year; figuring out how to update 2nd graders next.

Thank You PTO:

- Huge thank you to families your support is SO important!
- PTO typically helps to fund technology for the school previously purchased Promethean boards for all classrooms over the course of a few years. Now some boards are getting older, so will begin updating with new projection screens, starting with 4th grade (entire grade at a time, theirs are the oldest at this time).
- PTO finishes teacher's Donors Choose (1 per year, per teacher request) up to \$300 per classroom.

Communications from Bradley:

- School communicates by voicemail (much fewer from here on out) and Deets/messenger. Discussions:
 - Deets can translate into 5 languages; useful for teachers to communicate 1:1 with parents.
 - If having issues with listening to a voicemail (restarting, etc.) some parents mentioned this issue and found it was helpful to not have the voicemail on speaker, as when it hears background noise it may keep restarting.

Parent Questions for Mr Wera:

- Will there be field trips this year? Yes, we are already planning field trips - most will be in the spring semester most likely. First planned field trip will be 1st grade to the pumpkin patch in October.
- Will parents be able to volunteer to help at field trips? Yes!
 Parents/caregivers interested in volunteering to help at field trips will be allowed, but they must show proof of covid vaccine AND pass the DPS

volunteer background check

(https://app.sterlingvolunteers.com/en/Candidates/Account/Register) prior to joining the field trip. Parents most likely will not be allowed to ride the bus, but would meet at the field trip site (ECE may be an exception, unknown so far).

- Will there be enrichments this year? Yes, teachers are already planning these and you will get a detailed list for the first quarter options in this week's Friday Folder.
- Will there be family nights at Bradley this year? In typical, pre-covid years, we had nights where all the family was invited to come to Bradley for pizza dinner, potluck desserts and topic focused fun in various classrooms Math Night, Literacy Night, Fitness Night. We are unable to allow parents into the school at this time, but we are hopeful we may be able to do something perhaps outdoors at some point or virtually.
- Can parents organize class-wide gatherings of families on the playground? Yes, that is fine, please coordinate with teachers for this.
 No food or potlucks are allowed and must be restricted to outside.

Covid news:

- Students can move around their classroom now.
- Lunch 1 grade level goes to the cafeteria at a time.
- Recess only 1 grade at a time. Slightly longer lunch/recess time than last year to prevent mixing of grades.
- Cafeteria "New Friend Thursdays and Fridays" they have to sit in a different spot in the cafeteria each day to be sure everyone is included and students make new friends.
- No mask breaks during the school day outside of lunch/recess. Last year there were breaks outside with no masks for the students, but this turned into many extra recesses and took away from learning minutes.
- First covid case of the school year occurred today.
- New procedures for covid =
 - ask that students get tested as soon as possible exposure or symptoms. If negative, can return with proof of negative test. If positive, guarantine (student will be notified length of time).
 - School wide will be notified of a covid case, but no details.
 - Only individuals with direct contact with a positive student/staff will be notified individually and will be consulted about quarantine.
 - Students are great about wearing masks and know when they can take them off.
 - New Schedule: Returned to regular scheduled hours in each day of school again = can get full 45 minutes of specials again - yay!

PTO Updates

• Financial Update:

- In the process of transitioning to a new treasurer this year (Nao Smith is our new treasurer and Erik Towt, outgoing treasurer, is assisting).
- We plan to have a complete financial update at the October meeting.
- o 2020-2021 School Year Summary:
 - Ended the year ~\$3,500 ahead!
 - Last year and the previous 4 years PTO has had record setting revenue years compared to the year before thank you Bradley families for all your support!
- 2020-2021 Fundraiser Breakdown (profits; approximate):
 - \$10,000 Read-a-Thon;
 - \$10,000 King Soopers Community Rewards;
 - \$10,000 Auction (spring 2020 rescheduled to fall)
 - \$5,000 Dines Out (typically \$350-900 per event);
 - \$20,700 2019 Fun Run; and
- 2021-2022 Fundraising Goal: \$75,000 (Fun Run \$25,000, Read-a-Thon \$25,000, King Soopers \$15,000 = \$65,000)
- Nearly all of the money PTO earns is given directly back to the students.
 PTO always tries to spend money on things that will benefit the students and teachers right now, this year.
- Examples of what the PTO money funds:
 - Technology upgrades for the technology lab and classrooms new white boards/promethean boards, projectors, computers, etc.
 - School wide supports library books, new outdoor signs, etc.
 - Student & Classroom supports finishing out teachers' Donor Choose projects, white boards for all students, free tutoring, etc.

2021 Fun Run

 Planned for Friday, October 1 (bad weather makeup day will be the following week on Oct 8, if needed). All students run together with their grade during their Specials time, regardless of fundraising efforts.
