Principal Wera's Updates:

- DPS is going to soon stop requiring notices when there is a covid exposure.
- Budget CSC meeting is next week.
 - Projections for next year is down 10 kids
 - Trying to get more psychologists (Zach is full time with Bradley; will try and get Kendra at least part time next year)
- Parent Conferences coming at the end of trimester = March 4. Will be held as needed the week of Feb 23.
- After 4 p.m. on March 4 you can login to your DPS Parent Portal to see student's performance
- March 3 is a Drop Everything and Read Day pj day, catch up on AR, etc. so the entire day will be focused on reading. Another on April 11 to kick off the Read-a-Thon.
- Outdoor Classroom for entire school should start construction over spring break.
 Will have a digital display board that will be on wheels and can be brought out and used in the outdoor classroom.

- \$14,750 bond money available

- Request that the Displays are mounted low for ECE, etc. and be mounted age appropriately for the class.

 - Stacia Motioned; Stacy 2nd
 - All in favor 10; Opposed 0
- ECE requesting shade outside for outdoor classes, etc. Will check with the Denver Preschool Program to see if we can find funding available.
- Mr Wera is going to ask the groundskeeping team about the best option for paving the walkway going around the side of the school off Elm toward the Kindergarten doors.
