- PTO Gives Back
 - Giving back to teachers!
 - Fun Run: 20% of classroom earnings go directly to the class where it was raised- should this increase to 30% if we get 100% participation (donation any amount) in a class? Let's VOTE!!
 - Read-a-thon: 40% of classroom proceeds go back to each teacher OR grade level earnings can be combined and divided equally among the teachers in that grade
 - Donors Choose (PTO will close out one project per teacher, up to \$300)*
 - Grade Level Grants (each grade gets \$500 to use however the classrooms agree - funds need to be requested)
 - Giving back to students via scholarships for field trips or enrichment programs
 - Allowed twice per year per student (funds need to be requested)
 - Free tutoring for all students
 - Giving back to Bradley
 - Capital improvements, technology, etc.
